- Considerable experience of geotechnical report writing and design including foundations, piling, vibroflotation, slope stability, mining, retaining wall and earthworks assessment, analysis and design to understand the requirements needed to design the Ground Investigation.
- Considerable experience of environmental issues including Phase 1 Desk Studies, Phase 2 Ground Investigations, Remediation Strategies and Verification of contaminated land, landfill gas, etc.
- Full UK drivers licence.

The position involves the day to day organisation, co-ordination, supervision and undertaking of the company's contracting workload.
